

CAUTION: This mount is intended for use with weights not exceeding maximum weight capacity of 132lbs. The wall itself must be capable of supporting 4X the stadard weight. Please don't over tighten screws in order to avoid any injury. Use with products heavier than the maximum weights indicated may result in collapse of the mount and its accessories causing possible injury.




Figure 1 (keep the wall plate level)

Step 1: Please remove the plaster board on the surface of a concrete wall when assembling the mount on a concrete wall. Hold wall plate (A) against the wall at desired position on a concrete wall. Then, using a pencil, mark 4 hole locations. Then drill holes according pencil marks using 3/8" size drill bit to a depth of 2.5". Insert wall anchors (I) into holes. You may need to use hammer to lightly tap wall anchors into the wall. Then fix wall plate (A) to the wall with screws (H) and washers (J). (Figure 1)





Figure 2 (keep the wall plate level)

CAUTION: The concrete wall must have a minimum thickness no less than 5.5", and any surface covering can be no more than 3/8". If you mount the TV mount into wood studs, pre-drill the 4 mark holes using a 7/32" drill bit to a depth of 2.5". Then fix wall plate unit (A) to the wall with screws (H) and washers (J). (Figure 2)

CAUTION: The wood stud minimum size is 2x4", and any surface covering cannot exceed more than 5/8". Drill holes on the wooden stud's middle line.

A CAUTION: Don't use on concrete block.

Wood Double Studs

Step 2: Attach TV bracket (B) to the back of the TV. Choose the corresponding bolt, washer and spacer to fit the holes on the rear of your TV.

If the back of TV is not flat, or the bolts used to assemble TV are too long, or there is interference between TV bracket and cable inlets, we highly recommend that you use spacers.

CAUTION: Using incorrect bolts may damage your TV.



Step 3: Hang the pre-assembled TV unit on the wall plate and then tighten the safety screws(Figure 5)

ACAUTION:This step must require 2 or more professional to finish.




Step 4: You may need to loosen the handle to adjust the TV to your desired angle. Please remember to fasten the handle tightly after adjustment. (Figure 8)



PAY EXTRA CARE AND ATTENTION WHEN YOU FASTEN TWO TV MOUNTS TO THE BACK PANEL OF THE TV IN STEP 2. MAKE SURE THE APPROPRIATE MOUNTING HARDWARE IS BEING USED PROPERLY.

1. Select correct mounting hardware according to the screw hole size of your TV and discard any remaining screws or spacers.

2. Carefully lay your TV on its face on a non-abrasive surface, making sure to lay padding underneath it so as not to damage the screen.

3. Place left TV mount and right mount in the appropriate positions, making sure they are CENTERED on the back of the TV and LEVEL with one another.

4.This product may only be installed on perpendicular walls and not installed on ceilings.
